 Resumption of Full Power Operation

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On March 11, 2015, MHR License LLC (“MHR”), licensee of FM station WVBW, Suffolk, Virginia, filed a request with the Commission to operate the station with reduced power. MHR pointed out that Station WVBW had been operating at 70% of licensed power while the licensee and Verizon Wireless (“Verizon”) worked together to track down an elusive source of interference.

On April 9, 2015, the Media Bureau granted Special Temporary Authority (“STA”) to “continue to operate [WVBW] at reduced power, as needed.” The aforementioned STA is scheduled to expire on October 6, 2015.

This is to advise the Commission that on March 24, 2015, Station WVBW resumed operation with its licensed facilities. During the time since the station has operated with full power. On May 22, 2015, representatives of MHR met with representatives of Verizon and confirmed that the interference problem has been resolved. MHR requests that the STA be terminated because no interference is being caused to the facilities of Verizon Wireless.
